GOD'S PROMISE TO NOAH

MAIN POINT: God Keeps His Promises

BIBLE STORY: Noah's Ark

MEMORY VERSE: Trust in the Lord with all your heart. - Proverbs 3:5

FREE PLAY

(Free time: kids play with toys and interact with each other for the first 15 minutes of service)

CLEAN UP

Transition (Kids clean up)

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VOUS KID VALUES

SAY: “Okay, Heroes, before we sing our worship songs today, let’s go over our VK Values! Everyone repeat after me: ‘VK Values!’”

1. LISTENING EARS

(Hand Motion: Hands behind your ears)

2. KIND MOUTH

(Hand Motion: Hands on the side of your mouth facing out)

3. HELPING HANDS

(Hand Motion: Hands with palm up, one hand on top of another)

4. HUMBLE HEART

(Hand Motion: Both hands forming the shape of a heart on your chest)

5. POSITIVE ATTITUDE

GOD'S PROMISE TO NOAH

(Hand Motion: Each pointer finger on their cheek dimples as they smile)

WORSHIP (each song will have a video/ dance to sing along to)

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SNACK TIME & PRAYER

Snack leader:

“Open and shut them, open and shut them, put your hands in your lap. Open and shut them, open and shut them, put your hands in a Clap.” “Tick, tock, tick, tock. This is how we pray.”

PRAYER:

“God is great (Children repeat)
God is good. (Children repeat)
Lord we thank you, (Children repeat)
for our food. (Children repeat)
We thank you for (Children repeat)
our work and play. (Children repeat)
We thank you for (Children repeat)
this happy day. (Children repeat)
And all the VOUS Kids said----” AMEN!

GOD'S PROMISE TO NOAH

Transition (Clean up empty cups and snacks and wipe down wet tables)

- SONG: Sure I'd love to
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BIBLE LESSON (Gather children together and share lesson of the day)

- SUPPLIES: Noah puppet, 2 Animal puppets, stage, Bible

Set the stage: *2 servant leaders will hide behind the stage. One will be **Ham** and **Animal #1**. The other will be **Ham's Wife** and **Animal #2**. The Narrator will be acting as **NOAH** (dressed in Biblical costume) and will stand to the side of the stage where the kids can see you.*

NOAH: "Hello, friends! Come sit over here with me. It's time to hear our TRUE story straight from the Bible. (Hold up Bible). My name is Noah, and I want to tell you a story about how God keeps his promises!"

NOAH: "A long time ago, God told me, Noah, to build a really, really, REALLY (stretch arms out wide) big boat called an ark. Can everyone say, "ARK"? (**ARK!**) I had never seen a boat that big before, but I trusted God and built the ark just like God told me to."

"Then, God told me to fill the ark with two of every animal—one boy and one girl."

*****ENTER THE ANIMAL PUPPETS TO THE STAGE**

Animal #1: "Hey Heroes! I'm so happy Noah is telling this story!"

Animal #2: "Yeah! When we got to the ark, we saw that it was SO big! There was enough room for every kind of animal! The elephants, lions, giraffes, and even the birds could fly around in there!"

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Animal #1: “Right! And after all us animals got inside the ark, Noah’s family came too!”

***ENTER **HAM** AND **HAM’S WIFE**

Ham: “Hi there, Heroes! My name is Ham! I came on the boat with my brothers, Shem and Japheth and our wives. This is my wife, here! Say hi to the kids, honey!”

Ham’s Wife: “Hi kids! Yes, when Ham’s dad Noah told us to get inside the ark, we listened. We knew we had to trust God to save us.”

NOAH: (Speaking to the puppets) “That’s right, my children, we obeyed God. Once we were inside the ark, God shut the door! And good thing, because soon it began to rain!”

(Speaking to the VOUS Kids) “Heroes, can you help me make it sound like rain in here? *(Start to rapidly pat the tops of your legs to make noise. When all the kids are doing this together, it sounds like rain!)*

Animal #1: “Ohhh it sounds like a giant rainstorm in here!”

NOAH: “Great! Keep it up, Heroes! The Bible says it rained for 40 days and 40 nights until the WHOLE world was covered in water! Okay, on my count, we’re going to make the rain stop! Ready? One, two, three, STOP!” *(The room should go quiet).*

Ham: “Noah and our entire family were kept safe on the ark, though, because Noah believed God’s promise. Finally, the water went down, and land began to appear.”

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Ham's Wife: "That's right! Then, finally, after being inside the ark for all that time, God told Noah it was safe to come out! We all came out of the ark onto dry ground."

Animal #2: "God kept us safe, just like He had promised Noah! And then came the rainbow!"

NOAH: *(Show the rainbow prop)* "The rainbow was a sign of the promise between God and every living creature that God would never flood the whole earth again. I love it when I see a rainbow, because it helps me remember that God keeps His promises."

Transition to Craft (Gather children at table, prepare all crafts)

- SONG: Double the fun

CRAFT TIME: Water and Ark

- SUPPLIES: Print out of Water, precut arks, glue sticks and animal stickers.
- DIRECTIONS:
 1. Pass out crayons and printouts of water and ark.
 2. Allow children to color.
 3. Have Servant Leaders write names of children on the back of the coloring sheet.
 4. Help children paste ark on the water.
 5. Pass out animal stickers and help children stick them on the ark.

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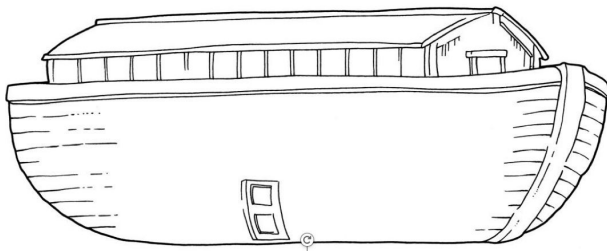
